TULSA, (June 13, 2007)- Flintco, Inc. has been awarded the top two honors at the National Associated Builders and Contractors (NABC) Excellence in Construction awards for two projects constructed by its Tulsa-based operations.

Flintco was honored with the first place Eagle award for its Koweta Indian Healthcare Facility, and the second place Pyramid award for its restoration of the old Tulsa Fire Alarm building for the American Lung Association.

The Koweta Indian Healthcare facility features 22 exam rooms, a dental clinic and rooms designated for physical therapy, X-ray and mammography.

The company was also honored with the second place Pyramid Award for its restoration of the old Tulsa Fire Alarm building for the American Lung Association.

The building, which had been left abandoned for over 20 years, called for several improvements including a new roof and new windows and doors. And, due to the historic nature of the building, all improvements had to comply with historical standards to ensure the correct look remained.

“The Excellence in Construction awards program recognizes the quality and innovation of merit shop construction and honors all members of the construction team including the contractor, the owner and the design team,” said ABC president and CEO Kirk Pickerel.

These awards are unique in that they are not design awards, but take into account difficult situations in construction that were overcome with innovative solutions as well as safety as previously mentioned. Both projects had zero accidents including all subcontractors.
